Dates of Significance Lent (orthodox) March 2 **Lent**, in the Christian <u>church</u>, a period of penitential preparation for<u>Easter</u>. In Western churches it begins on <u>Ash Wednesday</u>, six and a half weeks before Easter, and provides for a 40-day <u>fast</u> (Sundays are excluded), in imitation of <u>Jesus Christ</u>'s <u>fasting</u> in the wilderness before he began his public ministry. In Eastern churches Lent begins on the Monday of the seventh week before Easter and ends on the Friday that is nine days before Easter. This 40-day "Great Lent" includes Saturdays and Sundays as relaxed fast days.
